

**Moses-in-the-Cradle** plant is native to southern Mexico and Central America, and grows to approximately 30 cm (11.8 inches). Moses-in-the-Cradle's scientific name was originally *Rhoeo discolour*, then *Rhoeo spathacea*, and it is now *Tradescantia spathacea*.

## Lighting

Grow your plant in bright light year-round for good foliage color and flowers. It will tolerate lower light, but the leaves will be more green than purple.

## Watering

Keep soil evenly moist spring through fall. In winter, allow the potting medium to dry out slightly between waterings.

## Fertilizing

Fertilize during spring and summer, using a balanced houseplant fertilizer diluted to half its strength.

## **General Info**

The sap of Moses-in-the-Cradle plants can cause stinging and will burn one's mouth and throat if any of the plant is consumed.
